3. Flooring Maple hardwood in two different finishes from Armstrong brings personality to the floor. The boards—installed in stripes three boards wide—create a large-scale pattern. The linear look is repeated in the shelf of the island table, which was designed using KraftMaid Cabinetry.

4. Curtains Behind these panels of stain-resistant Sunbrella fabric, you'll find a full kitchen with all the bells and whistles. (The panels hang from a \$30 curtain system from West Elm.) A suite of KitchenAid appliances, including a 1930s-inspired in-sink dishwasher (see *page 110*), offer convenience in a small space.

5. Shelves We've long loved Dupont Corian solid surfaces for the great look it brings to counters, but we wanted to put this material to the test. With a clever concept and fabricator, we created wall-mount shelves and brackets that not only look good but also withstand kitchen moisture better than wood.
